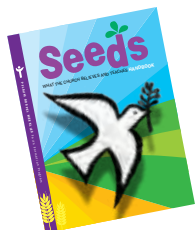
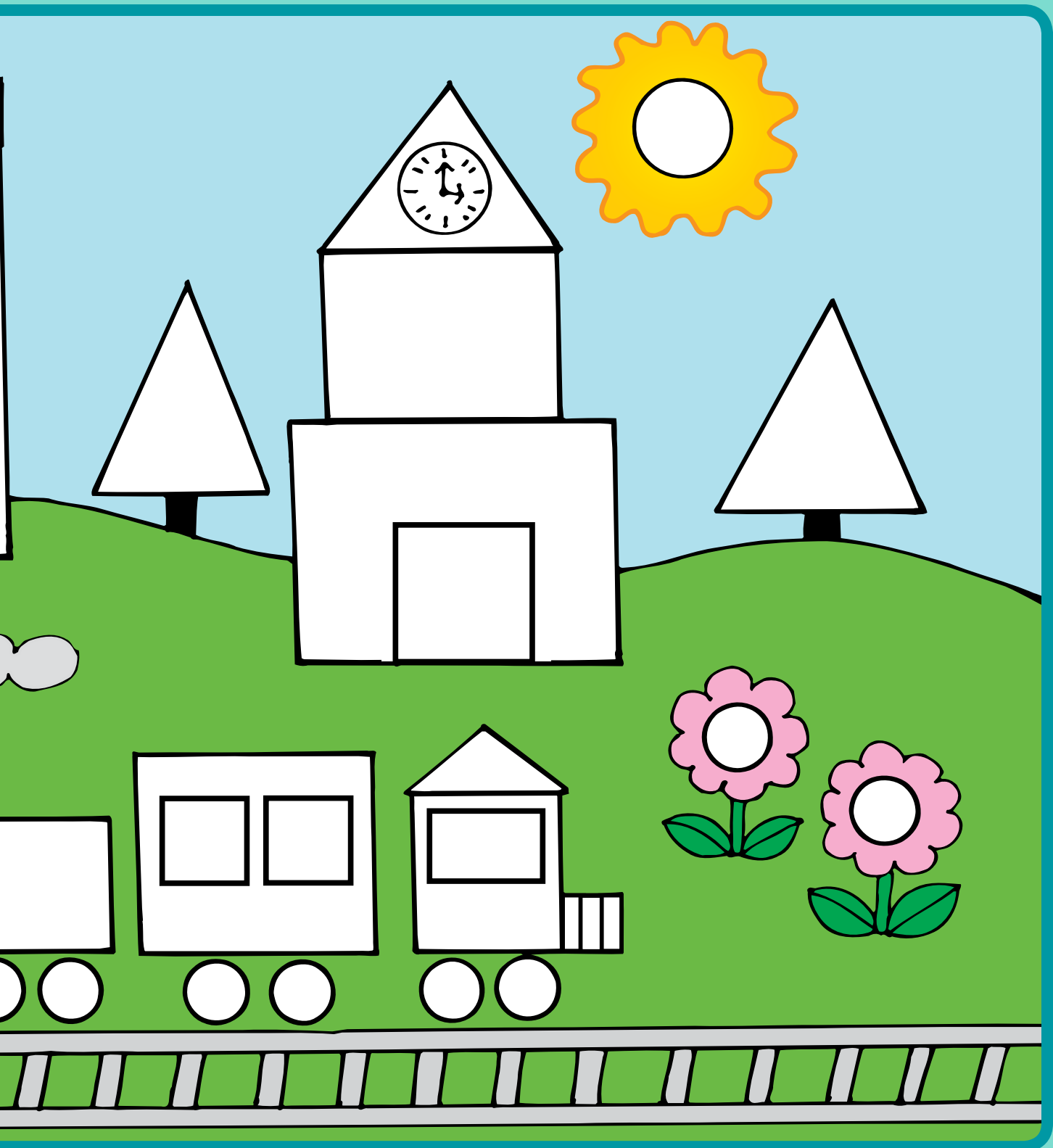
If you were blind and could suddenly see, who or what would you be most excited to see?

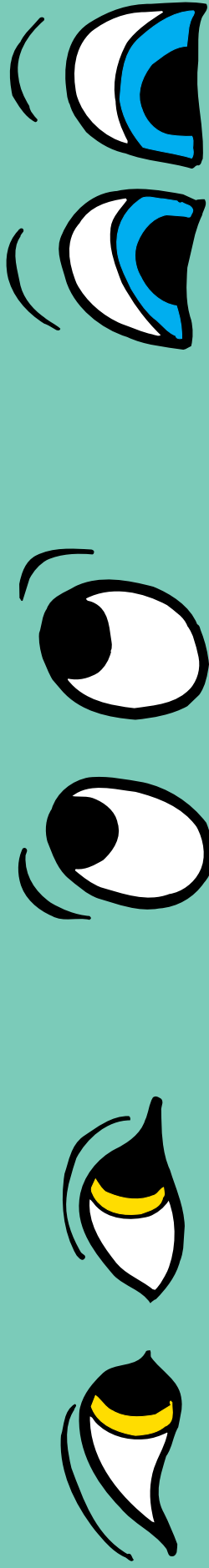
